# LESSONS

Pirate Academy may have some similarities to your own school, but there will likely be a few differences too! The lessons attended by “Barracuda Class”, for instance, might be a tad different to those on your own school timetable...

Each day at Pirate Academy begins with **Strength, Stamina & Motivation**. For the Barracudas, this means a brisk 5 km run around the lush Academy gardens. “SSM” is the brainchild of Captain Pavel Platonov, but several of the teaching captains take part.

Captain Lisabeth Quivers teaches **Knots Class** – her classroom is known as “Knots Lab”.

**Treasure Class** is taught by the Deputy Headcaptain, Captain Mayday Salt.

**Combat Workshop** is taught by Captain Victor Molina, known to be one of the most accomplished swordfighters in pirate history.

Talking of **Pirate History**, this is currently taught by Captain Porfirio Wrathe. He also has the exciting and mysterious title – “Librarian of Swords”.

Three of the Academy’s teaching captains instruct the Barracudas in **Sailing Class**. They are Captain Pavel Platonov, Captain Shivaji Singh and Captain Floris van Amstel.

Captain Kirstin Larsen (Leif Larsen’s mum) teaches **Navigation by Map and Moon**.

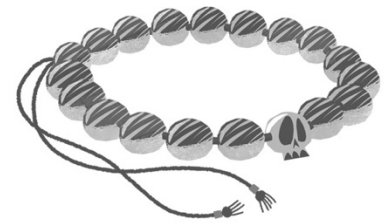

# BURY YOUR TREASURE

Here's a challenge from Captain Salt to you. Draw a map of an island. Where will you moor your ship? Where will you hide your treasure? What obstacles will be in the way? How will you stop other pirates finding your loot? How will YOU remember where you hid it?

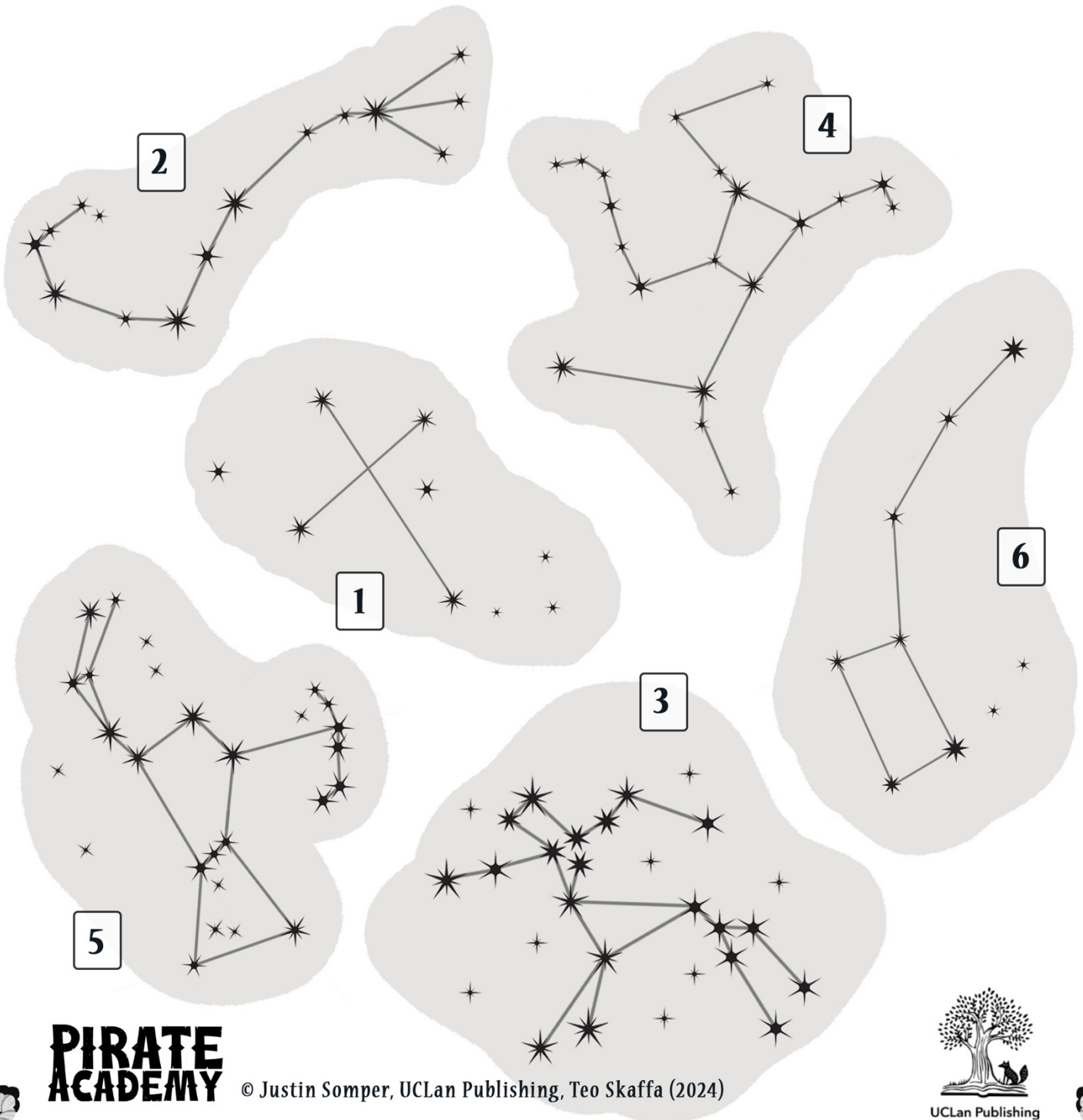

# DESIGN A NEW UNIFORM

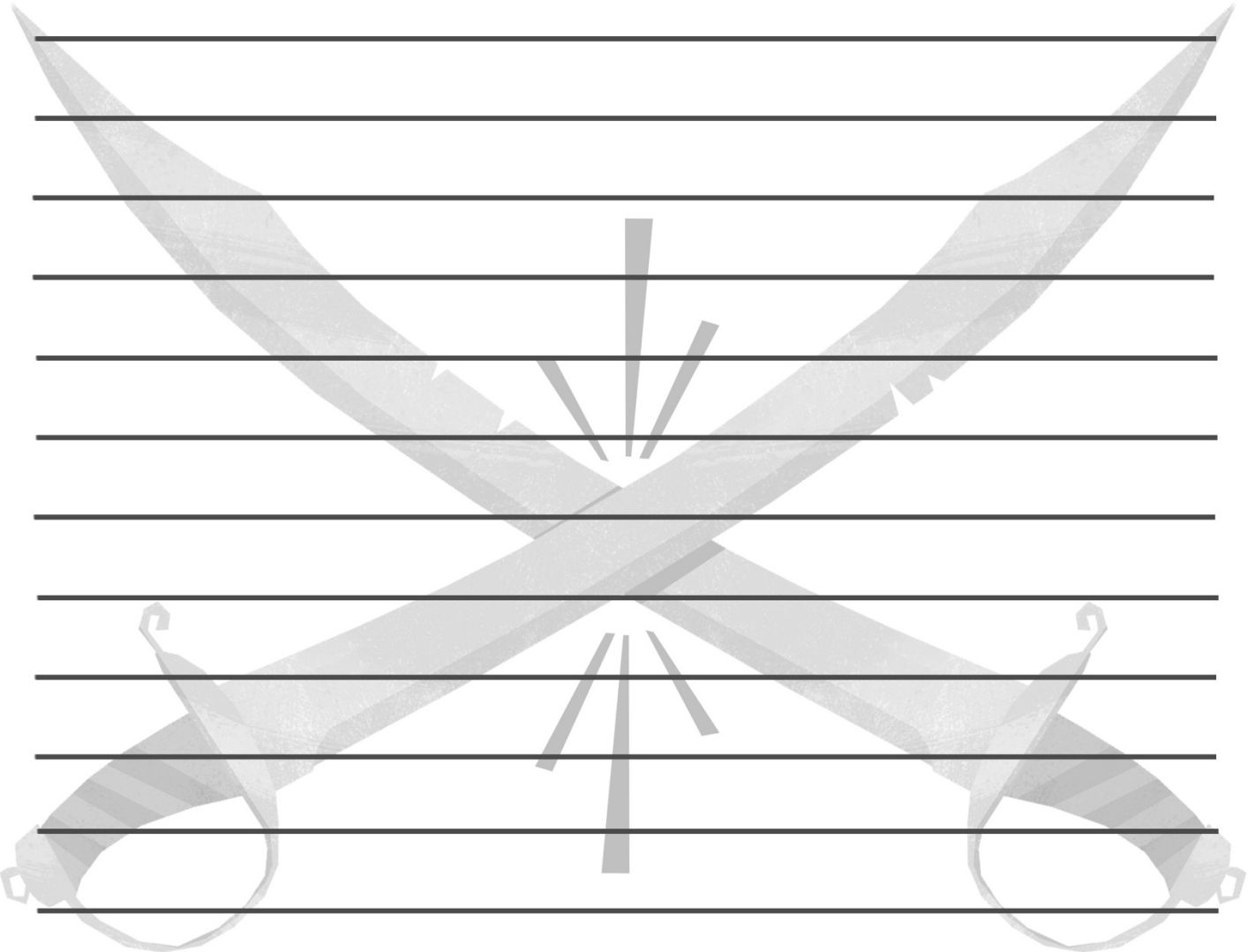

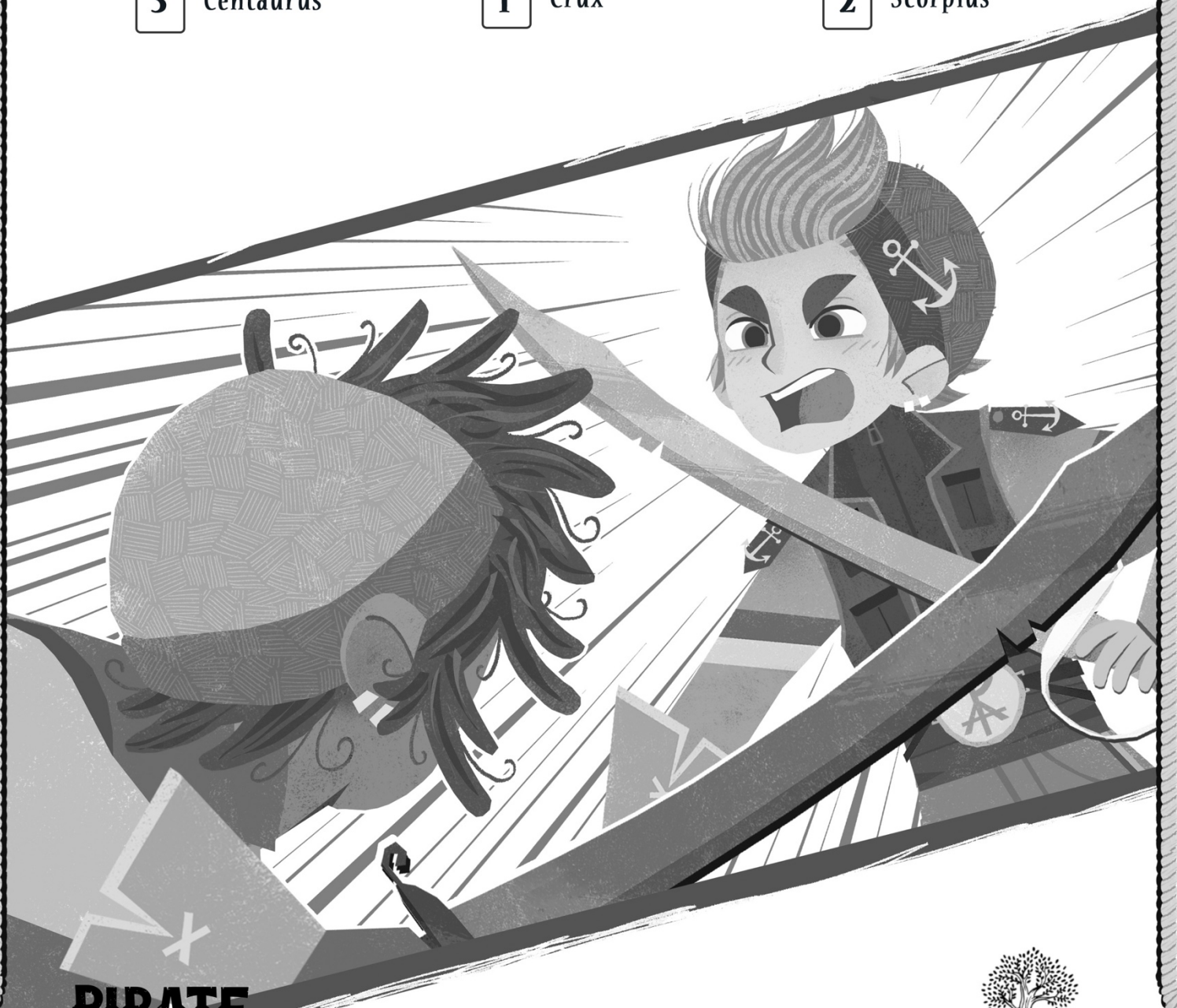
